A STRONG FOCUS ON BELGIAN FILM AT THE SECOND EDITION OF THE BRUSSELS INTERNATIONAL FILM FESTIVAL.

NATIONAL COMPETITION

The National Competition at the second edition of BRIFF highlights Belgian talent and offers the opportunity to discover films with a Belgian touch.

Antwerp film maker Mathieu Mortelmans presents his first feature film *Bastaard*, Virginie Gourmel makes her debut with her feature film *Cavale* and Liège director Nicolas Graux shows his first documentary *Century of Smoke*. This competition also highlights Belgian co-productions with international talents: Sacha Polak's *Dirty God*, the opening film at the IFFR in Rotterdam; Juris Kursietis' *Oleg*, which was partly shot in Brussels and selected for the Directors' Fortnight at Cannes and Rebecca Daly's *Good Favour*, screened at the TIFF in Toronto.

As a true Brussels film festival, Belgorama brings together Flemish and French-speaking films: Bas Devos' *Hellhole*, in which he explores the capital through the lives of three of its residents, four-time Cannes winner *Girl*, Koen Mortiers *Engel* (*Un Ange*), Joachim Lafosse's *Continuer*, *Nos Batailles* by Guillaume Senez and the family film *Mon Ket* by François Damiens.
