CLAUDE LELOUCH PRESENTS HIS LATEST FILM AT THE CLOSING CEREMONY OF THE BRUSSELS INTERNATIONAL FILM FESTIVAL

French new wave director Claude Lelouch presents his new film *The Best Years of a Life* (*Les plus belles années d'une vie*) in Belgian premiere at the closing ceremony of the second edition of the Brussels International Film Festival. His 1966 debut film *Un homme une femme* was highly acclaimed and was awarded with the Palm d'Or at Cannes and the Oscar for best foreign film. With *The Best Years of a Life*, Lelouch directed his 49th film.

Jean-Louis Trintignant (*Amour, Il Conformista*) plays a former racer who lives in a retirement home where his son comes to visit him. His youthful years are in the past and his memories only resurface occasionally. When his son looks for his old lover Anne, played by Anouk Aimée (*Un homme et une femme*, *La dolce vita*), the two meet again and give their love a second chance.

Claude Lelouch will be personally present his film at the closing ceremony on 29 June.
